



IEEE CTSoc CSH TC - 2024 Meeting #1

Alessandro Tonacci, CTSoc CSH TC Chair, welcomes all the participants to the 1st CSH TC meeting of the year 2024, and presents the agenda.

- **Role call of the 1st CSH TC Meeting**
 - Tonacci compiles the list of participants. 9 members of the CSH are attending the event in the two time slots, with 2 further members already communicating their unavailability to attend.
 - The participation for the first time of two new members, Cheng-Hung Lin and Cheng-Kai Lu, was the occasion to let themselves present each other.
- **Report from the first Meeting with CTSoc Officers**
 - **Attractiveness and engagement of the Technical Committees (new applications, evaluation of performances, prizes, joint activities across TCs, outcomes and opportunities, social media)**

Tonacci explains what was discussed in the previous meeting with the CTSoc Officers, coordinated by the VP of Technical Committees, Prof. Lamberti. The situation of the CTSoc in terms of registered members is quite good, but a small part of the members is, in fact, active. In this regard, as TCs, we should be attractive to them, by spreading the voice about the activities of TCs, the opportunities granted, and seeking to attract “new bloods”, too, for the prosecution of the activities. In this regard, Marcantoni asked about the usefulness of spreading the voice to Master students, too, and Tonacci answered positively.

In the same direction, the CSH, together with other TCs, have started adopting a performance sheet to evaluate carefully the activity level of all TC members. The sheet is placed in the shared Google Drive folder and its filling will be reminded by e-mail together with the Minutes of the Meeting.

Tonacci informs about the initiative actually ongoing about the proposal of projects and activities CSH has supported, to be submitted to the CTSoc for evaluation, by means of the BoG, in terms of prizes and awards. Billeci proposes to eventually add to the existing proposals the possibility of granting funds for staff exchanges between institutions.

Tonacci points out the opportunities granted by the active participation to the CTSoc and TCs, among which, for example, the possibility to propose Special Issues in the CEM journal, and



invites potential interested members to inform the Officers in this regard. Prof. Hossain confirms the great opportunity in this regard.

Tonacci invites the members to apply for a role in the social media part of the TC. In particular, he presents the LinkedIn page of the VAM TC as a fruitful example of collaboration and dissemination, asking for interested members to cover the role. An e-mail concerning interest is then received just after the meeting by Chia-Chi Chang. Also, Cheng-Hung Lin and Cheng-Kai Lu, showed their interest for supporting this activity. A call for action will be launched shortly after the publication of the Minutes of the Meeting.

- **Conferences for 2024-2025 term**

Tonacci points out the actual initiatives by the CTSoc in terms of upcoming conferences, including GEM 2024, ICCE-Asia 2024, ICCE-Taiwan 2024 and ICCE 2025, inviting members to contribute to the success of the conference in terms of submissions of papers and participation to the TPCs.

- **Next Technical Talks (April 2024, with CSH) and new scheduling**

Tonacci informs about the next edition of the CTSoc Technical Talks (April, 12th), inviting members to attend to the event, especially considering that the CSH TC will deliver a speech in this occasion, by Lorenzo Bachi, about “Automatic electrocardiogram signal processing and its applications on healthcare devices”.

- **Roles within the CSH TC**

Tonacci outlines the roles (liaisons) within the CSH TC, highlighting the vacant ones (Technical Sister Societies Liaison) or the ones actually covered by current Officers (Education Liaison by Billeci, Future Direction Liaison by Tonacci), and asking for interest by the members to cover such positions.

- **Possible name redefinition for the CSH TC**

Tonacci points out the possibility to make the name of the CSH TC more actual with respect to the state-of-the-art in this regard, as happened in other TCs. All participants declare to be fine with the actual name of the TC, highlighting the importance of taking care of both aspects (healthcare and well-being) in the activities developed.

- **Future term Officers' elections (2025-2026)**

Tonacci introduces the possibility to start thinking about new officers' candidature for the new term elections (2025-2026), pointing out that, despite CSH was among the TCs where all the



Officers have been changed from the previous term, it is always good to have a rotation in the roles. Hossain candidates himself to serve as the Chair for the future term.

- **Open discussion**

Tonacci asks for eventual discussion on further topics of interest, receiving no positive feedbacks in this regard. Everybody present was fine with the topics discussed.

- **Closing remarks**

Tonacci closes the meeting highlighting the need for inviting new members and actively participating to the TC activities and to the CT Soc activities, at large, inviting everyone, as usual, to the next meeting, roughly in a 6-month time period.
