## **TC Officers Elections:**

Worawat explained TC officers' election, in which the current officers' term will end on December 31, 2022.

- TC Officers Elections will be held end of 2022 by the Nomination and Election (N&E) Subcommittee

- The Technical Committee Board (TCB) appoints the members of the N&E Subcommittee.

- TC Officers shall be TC members and CTSoc members from Jan 2023. They do not need to be CTSoc members at the time of nomination.

- Voters don't need to be CTSoc members yet for the incoming one but must be for subsequent elections.

- The N&E Subcommittee Chair shall send the election report to the TCB within two weeks from the election.

- Election results shall be ratified when approved by the TCB, with notification to the TC Chair within four weeks after receipt of the Election Report.

- If the TCB does not approve the election results, the TC shall organize a new election.

- At least two candidates on the ballot for each office position (Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary). If there are not enough nominations, the N&E Subcommittee shall identify additional candidates.
