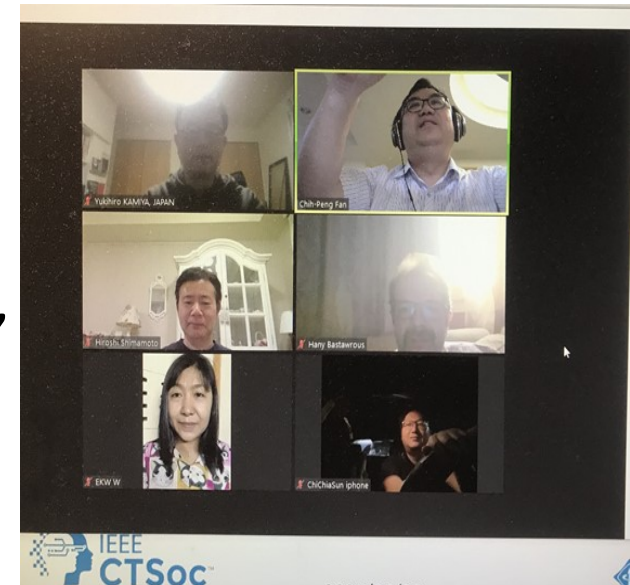

# Minutes of the previous meeting (1/2)

- ✓ How long is the **service period** for officers & members ?

By the document of CTSoc Operations Manual / Policies and Procedures (P&Ps)

## 1.1.2.2. Organizational Structure and Membership

→ CTSoc's membership or IEEE membership are not required for being a member of a Technical Committee.

### 1.1.3.1.2. Organizational Structure and Membership

All Technical Committees report to the Technical Committees Board.

Technical Committees shall have at least a Chair, Vice-Chair, and a Secretary and all shall be elected by the Technical Committee membership. Elections for Technical Committee officers shall be held every two years. Officers cannot serve more than two consecutive terms, and a term has a two-year duration.

### 1.1.3.1.3. Elected and Appointed Officers

Technical Committees shall have elected officers and may have appointed officers. After the first term in which officers have been invited and/or appointed, all elected officers shall be elected by the Technical Committee members. Appointed officers shall be appointed by the Technical Committee Chair.

All officers shall be Technical Committee members and CTSoc members, and shall serve two-year terms concurrent with the nominal term of the Technical Committee Chair.
